I give my permission for my child to use the Internet, email and other online services in school.

I understand that my child is accountable for his/her own actions

I understand that materials found on the Internet, including in computer games which may or may not be played online, can be offensive. I accept responsibility for setting standards for my child to follow when selecting, sharing and exploring information and media sources including social media.

To set standards for my child to follow, I agree not to use social networking sites (or similar) to bring the school, staff or pupils into disrepute.

I will support school staff to challenge my child's online and offline behaviours regarding technology use.

I will support my child's online activities in a positive and proactive way, seeking support from school staff or other appropriate sources for advice wherever needed.

I will tell a trusted adult if I see something that upsets me or I feel upset or threatened by something that has happened online. I will make talking to an adult about what I do online a regular event.

I will keep my username and password secret (but it's OK to tell my parents) and never give out any personal information online.

I understand that all of my digital conduct is traceable; by posting online, messaging and emailing I leave a 'digital footprint', even if the post is deleted. I will only post things that I would be happy to show my parents and teachers.

I will always follow the SMART rules (Safe, Meet, Accept, Reliable, Tell).

I will always be polite and considerate when I write on the computer and/or post online.

I understand that people online can be anyone in the world and I must make considered decisions about whether it is suitable to talk to people who I do not know when online. My parents need to help me make this decision.

School

We will ensure that your child receives relevant and age-appropriate e-safety advice throughout their time at school.

We will act quickly to ensure any inappropriate material is filtered.

We will set standards for your child to follow and agree not to use social networking sites to post material that could compromise the relationship between home and school.

We will deal with any issues from in school use of online services quickly and in line with the whole school behaviour policy.

We will provide access to advice and support for all parents regularly and in specific situations when needed.
