History

Anglo Saxons

Who were they? Where do they come from, why and where did they settle?

Vikings

Who were the Vikings & why did they attack Britain? What happened at Lindisfarne. Norse mythology, Viking homes and the Battle of Maldon

World War II

Battle of Britain, Blitz, rationing, evacuation and men & women's changing roles
Significant people – Churchill & Hitler

Modern Languages

All units include speaking, listening, reading and writing with a focus on the correct pronunciation.

Ask & answer a range of questions
Read & understand familiar written phrases
Write some familiar words & phrases from memory

France

Overview of Europe, identifying countries bordering France, seas & oceans.
Weather & climate, focusing on south East inc. comparison with England

Links to Viking/World War II topics

Map of Europe inc. countries, capitals, oceans & seas. Historical settlements, apply 2 figure grid references to OS map of local area

Science

In all aspects studied to continue to develop skills associated with working scientifically

Living Things

What is a habitat? Food chains and classification keys. Digestive system, teeth.

States of Matter

Classify according to solid, liquid or gas.
Investigate heating & cooling and changes of state. The water cycle inc. evaporation & condensation

Sound

How sounds are made. Investigating amplitude & pitch.

Electricity

Constructing & labelling simple circuits.
Investigate common conductors and insulators

Computing

Ongoing development of typing skills

Flowol, and Microsoft programs will be used to teach: Flow diagrams, command boxes, sequencing & debugging. Inserting images & text in Publisher. Cropping images & adding sounds & changing timing for transitions in PowerPoint.
Introduction to Excel to create a spreadsheet with simple formulas

Including reporting within websites & how to deal with unpleasant messages

Sikhism – life of Guru Nanak & Gobind Singh
Hinduism – Aum symbol, Trimurti and worship in home & temple
Sequencing the Christian story of Holy Week
Jesus' ministry, baptism, calling of disciples
Comparing sacred books & worship (Christianity & Sikhism)

Health & Wellbeing

Recognising and managing emotions. Managing risk & keeping safe in local environment. Drugs in everyday life

Relationships

Maintain positive friendships, think before we act, know what stereotypes & discrimination mean

Living in the Wider World

Why do we have rules & laws and why they are important for our safety. Understand personal environmental responsibilities

Music

Composition & instruments

Recorder – a, b & g & learning the National Anthem. Glockenspiel – recapping d,e,f & learning c. Composing own music using note names

Singing & Performance

Develop singing – correct posture & breathing, interrelated dimensions, different types of notes
Year 4 performance Spring Term

Listening & Understanding

Listening to a range of classical pieces linked to Vikings. Appraising range of WWII artists and the impact music had on morale

Design & Technology

Food Tech

Chop, grate, dice, stir and rub in – savoury scones. Exploring seasonality & discussing preferences - crepes.

Construction

Pop up books with a focus on leavers – labelled diagrams, craft knife use
WWII search lights, linking to electricity – exploded diagrams & lego kit

Art

Drawing

Observational drawing using a viewing square, introducing vanishing point, horizon & lines of perspective

Textiles

Sewing – stitch type, joining materials inc, applique

Painting

Claude Monet study, en plein air, water colour techniques

Printing

Impressed and relief blocks - one colour

Physical Education

Games

Tennis – forehand/back hand & under arm serve
Netball & hockey – accurate passing
Cricket – underarm balling, wicket keeper role & striking from a tee

Gymnastics & Dance

In gym (floor & apparatus) focus on changes in direction & speed within sequences. Incorporating Yr 4 specific rolls & jumps.
English country dancing, partner work to develop motifs & mood. Small group composition

Healthy Lifestyles

Circuit training – effect of exercise of the body

Athletics & Outdoor Adventurous Activities

Running techniques, jumps with varying take off & push throws. Orienteering using 8 pts of compass

Swimming

Developing stroke skills & stamina in swimming
