

Club and Event Participation Review

End of Academic Year 2023 to 2024

We have had another very successful year with our club participation and our sporting events. Our target this year was to maintain 80% participation and we finished the year with a figure of 83.2%. This is due to the significant number of events that we attended as well as introducing some more inclusive afterschool clubs such as our new games club. This club offered the children a chance to participate in a wide variety of new sports including orienteering, archery, dodgeball and badminton and was extremely popular across the three terms. The percentage split between boys and girls attending our after-school clubs is approximately 50/50.

74% of children with SEND attended a club or represented the school which is an improvement upon last year and is a figure that is achievable again next year. Our participation of children in receipt of PPG has dropped to 64% which is slightly below our target of 70% so this will be looked at next year.

Action Plan for Academic Year 2024/2025

We will be continuing to aim for at least 80% club participation for this academic year. Clubs have been reviewed and we will be offering new opportunities such as athletics club due to high interest and the introduction of our second athletics-based sports day event.

To improve our participation of children in receipt of PPG, we will ensure that we invite more children to our afterschool clubs.

We feel that our SEND participation percentage is achievable again for this academic year.
