

Club and Event Participation Review

End of Academic Year 2022 to 2023

This is the second year that clubs and events have taken place following the break due to Covid-19. Our aim this year was to have at least 80% of our students attending either a club or an event. Our actual figure is 82% which is above our target. Reasons for this are due to the increase in after school clubs and the high amount of events that we attended. Our target of 54% girl participation has also been attained as we have managed 55% girl participation this year. We are looking for this number to increase next year as we push girl's sport further especially girls' football.

70% of our pupil premium children attended either a club or event which matches our target however only 65% SEN children attended which although is higher than last year is below our target of 70%.

Overall our club attendance has been excellent and we will look at continuing this again for this academic year. We are also aiming to attend even more events with the Maldon consortium and maybe branch into the Chelmsford and Colchester events further.

Action Plan for Academic Year 2023/2024

We are aiming for at least an 80% participation figure once more, as we feel that this is a very reasonable target. To improve both our Pupil Premium figure and SEN figure we will be introducing a games club both during and after school. The during school club will focus on board and puzzle games and the after school one will focus on a variety of different sporting activities that includes archery, badminton, yoga and dodgeball. Participation will continue to be reviewed termly by the PE team.
